Exciting Finish Caps Crimson Victory at 129th **Edition of** *The Game*





More than 90 Harvard and Yale alumni and fans braved a rainy Southern California morning to come out to Yankee Doodles in Santa Monica and support their respective teams in the 129th edition of The Game on November 17, 2012 which was attended by 31,123 fans at Harvard Stadium. For their efforts, they were treated to one of the most exciting finishes in recent memory, one that would triumphantly end with another Crimson victory, its sixth in a row.

The outcome was anything but a given for most of the contest, with each team retaking the lead multiple times well into the fourth and final quarter of the game after a very quiet halftime score of 3-3. Trailing by four points in the final minutes of the game, Harvard quarterback, senior Colton Chapple '13, threw his final collegiate pass, a high ball, in a crowded end zone where Harvard tight end Cameron Brate used all of his 6'5" height to come down with the ball. The outcome would remain in question until Harvard scored one last touchdown with 1:19 remaining in the game to bring the final score to 34-24. Harvard (8-2, 5-2 Ivy League) ended second in the league behind the University of Pennsylvania.

Yalies, itching for their first win over Harvard since 2006, had their cheers (and microphones) ready for several rousing renditions of "Boola Boola" and "Bulldog." However, they were no match for the Harvard Club's Dr. Richard Allen Williams '57, whose trumpeted performances of "10,000 Men of Harvard" and "The Gridiron King" led Crimson fans in song.

Final score aside, a cordial atmosphere (with Harvard and Yale supporters mixed in together) was the order of the day, complete with a half time raffle of football memorabilia and free T-shirts for all Crimson attendees (commemorating the current win streak).

Overall, the 129th edition of The Game surely ranked as one of the most satisfying of the new millennium, leaving open the question of whether Harvard can surpass the all-time win streak of eight consecutive victories, currently owned by the Yale teams of 1880-1889 (Harvard banned football in 1885).


