Internationally renowned astronomer Jay Pasachoff, AB '63 MA '65 PhD '69, will talk about "Sizygy x 3: Eclipses, Transits, and Occultations". Prof. Pasachoff is the Field Memorial Professor of Astronomy at Williams College and an authority on solar eclipses. He is also the author of widely used textbooks in astronomy from high school and college levels.

His lecture will be preceded by an optional box dinner (6:30 PM, see below), a telescope viewing of the sun (7 PM), and a premiere viewing of a video entitled "First Light: The Telescope Changed Everything" (8 PM).
