Harvard College Admissions Update

Following a banner year in which Harvard College admitted the highest number of local students ever, 116 Southern California students enrolled at Harvard as freshmen for the fall term. A list of the matriculated students from our region may be found on page 4.

A record 2,606 applicants applied to Harvard College from Southern California for the Class of 2016. 148 local students were admitted to Harvard College. For the first time in recent memory, according to Marsha Hirano-Nakanishi, the Club's Vice Chair for Schools, our region's admit rate of 5.6% approximated the national admit rate.

Harvard College continues to attract and admit a diverse mix of students from our region. Entering Harvard freshmen from Southern California graduated from high schools with a tradition of sending high school students (Harvard-Westlake, Polytechnic, Brentwood, Palos Verdes, Santa Monica, etc.), but students also appeared from schools that may not have sent many students to Harvard College recently, including Arcadia, Franklin, Burbank, Birmingham, California Academy of Math and Science, Eagle Rock, Magnolia, and Manual Arts, according to Hirano-Nakanishi.

The high interest in Harvard College from Southland students means that the Club needs to recruit large numbers of local alumni interviewers. "Harvard is anticipating another record year for applications this year, and we expect Southern California to exceed last year's record level of interview requests," said Dan Medina, the Club's Vice President for Schools. "Admissions views the alumni interview as a critical component of a candidate's application, making it crucial for our area to have sufficient numbers of interviewers to meet the demands of the applicant pool," he said.




