### **President Faust Talks at Huntington Library on Death** and the Civil War

On October 31, 2012, Harvard President Drew Gilpin Faust spoke at The Huntington Library on her best-selling book: *This Republic of Suffering:* Death and the American Civil War. With more

than 200 people attending the lecture, Faust, a Civil War historian, spoke about her research for the book, which involved what President Lincoln referred to as the "awful arithmetic of war" -- the carnage that resulted in the death of 2.5% of the American population at the time. The unprecedented scale of war deaths had an impact on the American people who worked to improvise new solutions, institutions, and ways of coping with death on an unimaginable scale.

Filmmaker Ric Burns adapted the book into a new PBS documentary, Death and the Civil War, which examines how the carnage resulted in national cemeteries, Memorial Day celebrations and most importantly, the obligation to reclaim, bury and honor the corpses of fallen warriors.

Accompanying Faust were actors Angela Basset and husband Courtney B. Vance (AB '82) who read the Gettysburg address as part of Faust's presentation.




